In the interests of everyone please make sure all mobile phones are switched off at commencement of shooting.

Shooting will be under GNAS Rules.

Proof of GNAS membership may be requested at registration.

Archers must conform to GNAS dress regulations (those not complying will not be allowed to shoot. Rule 107.) Crossbows, professional archers and substitutes are not allowed.

Entries on the day are NOT allowed. Late entries accepted according to space available but no later than 20th July 2024

Record Status shoots will be liable to drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Juniors must ensure that a Parent or Guardian signs their entry form, giving consent to a drug test, if required.

Timed ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes will apply throughout this shoot

There will be 4 archers per target shooting in two details

This is a Senior event, Juniors can enter but will shoot the Senior distances

Awards are given for the two day accumulative score

A Novice is an archer who has not yet completed their first year of affiliation

Vetrans are Ladies over 60 and Gentlemen over 65

Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser at the time of entry as to their requirements whilst shooting so target allocation can be suitable.
